Opening

Light the Advent wreath or candle, if used, with care. The household may stand or sit quietly.

V. Make haste, O God, to deliver me.

R. *Make haste to help me, O Lord.*

Household Petition

Advent Collect

Stir up, we beseech Thee, Thy power, O Lord, and come; that by Thy protection we may be rescued from the threatening perils of our sins, and saved by Thy mighty deliverance; who livest and reignest with the Father and the Holy Ghost, ever one God, world without end. Amen.

Jesus Prayer

Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner. Amen.

Simple Advent Practices

Pray Morning or Evening Prayer; read the appointed Scriptures or a Gospel lesson; light the Advent wreath with care, if used; sing an Advent hymn; and give attention to repentance, mercy, and Christ's promise.

Weekly Use

Sunday. Pray after the Divine Service or before the evening meal, giving thanks for the Word preached.

Weekdays. Use the Psalm verse, Kyrie, household petition, and Jesus Prayer as a short evening devotion.

Saturday. Prepare for the Lord's Day by confessing sin, setting out Bible and hymnal, and praying for the Church.
